## Electric Outlet

---

The electricity in China is generally 220V.

There are two kinds of sockets in China. The first one is Type A where the prongs must be the same size, although many modern devices with Type A plugs have one wider prong. The type with one wider prong won't fit into a Chinese wall socket and will require an adapter. This socket will also take a "Type C" or "Type F" plug that is standard in Europe. (European plugs work in China, and use the same voltage. USA plugs work in China, but you must make sure the voltage is supported by your device for 220V.)
