*Japan has been a leading country in environmental protection as well as waste minimization. Since the 'Waste Revolution' in the 70's, Japan has set concrete targets to reduce waste, which has been supported by government policies, community engagement as well as the right technology. During 6-8 December, Japan Environmental Management Association for Industry (JEMAI) will be organizing the 20th EcoPro 2018, and this year's theme is Environment and Society of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Era, and to the Future.*

*Japan has set the target of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 2030 to minus 26% compared with the fiscal 2013 level, and the foundation for its substantial efforts has been improved. In addition, the "Government for Promotion of Sustainable Development (SDGs) promotion headquarters" with the prime minister as the top by the Japanese government was established.*

*Also at Nippon Keidanren, "achieving SDGs" is listed in the Charter of Corporate Behavior last year, and it is thought that the movement to promote SDGs will become more popular. In the future, efforts towards a sustainable society will be further accelerated both in Japan and overseas.*



In addition to collecting various stakeholders surrounding the environment, such as business people with a high interest in the environment, general consumers, administrative / local governments, NPOs, students for environmental education, We are endorsed as an unfamiliar exhibition and we are going to be holding the 20th this year. We will develop it as an event to solve problems and problems that are occurring in various societies, mainly environmental issues, with the theme "Environment, Society and the Future of the SDGs Era".

In addition to conducting various projects, under the concept of creating a sustainable society, we set up a new exhibition "Social Infrastructure 2018" for exhibiting infrastructure aging measures and intelligent infrastructure utilizing IoT and AI for this year. We will hold simultaneously for the first time. For this reason, we hope that this exhibition aiming to build a sustainable society can be used as a place for business matching, information gathering and environmental learning.
